Your child needs to discuss the content of the book to help develop their comprehension skills and the breadth of their vocabulary.

Please can you ensure that your child brings their reading book and reading record book in to school every day.

The **homework grid** provides suggestions of other tasks that you can choose to complete over the half term.

Topic this half term....

- In Science, we will be learning about habitats and what a habitat needs to provide. We will
 discuss living and non-living things and begin to explore food chains and adaptation.
- In **History**, we will be continuing to learn about significant people and their impact.
- In **Geography**, we will be learning about hot and cold areas around the world, comparing Somalia with the UK. We will also discuss sustainability and looking after our planet.
- In **D.T**, we will be looking at where our food comes from, how it is prepared and how we can follow recipes. We will look at our school lunches and suggest new meal ideas.
- In Art, we will be learning about the work of significant still life artists and still life techniques. We will learn about artists' use of colour and composition before creating our own still life arrangements and artwork.
- In RE, we are discussing the big question "What makes some places special to believers?'
 We will find out about the features of churches, mosques and synagogues and consider the similarities that all places of worship have and how they support their local communities in practical ways.
- In **Music**, we will begin by exploring five of the movements from Carnival of the animals by Camille Saint-Saëns, exploring how he used instruments, rhythm, articulation, tempo, and pitch to create pictures of the animals in our imaginations. We will then explore music inspired by birds, beginning by watching and listening to birds, and gathering inspiration for our own compositions. We will then learn how to make birdsong motifs and structure them into a piece
- In Computing, we will take inspiration from a range of artists to create our own digital paintings using a range of creative tools.
- In **PSHE**, we will be celebrating differences between our classmates and recognising that everyone is unique.
