School improvement focus

Our focus this half term is:

- SEND Provision

English

In Reception we will be learning to write CVC captions and short sentences.

In Year 1 we will learn how to create fact-files and write our own version of a narrative. We will also be focusing on using adjectives and conjunctions in our sentences, ensuring we edit them carefully for punctuation and meaning.

The books we will be exploring are *Astro Girl* by Ken Wilson-Max and *Look Up* by Nathan Bryon.

Maths

This half term we will be covering:

Year 1 - Place Value and addition and subtraction within 20.

Reception – Subitising, counting, ordinality and cardinality, composition within 5 and 10 and mass and capacity.

Topics this term: Once Upon a Time and Sparkle and Shine

In **Science** we will be learning about the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. We will also explore how materials can be changed through bending, stretching, squashing and twisting.

In **Music**, we will develop our active listening skills through listening to various pieces of music, develop a sense of beat by performing actions, and explore the range and capabilities of voices through vocal play.

In **RE** we will be looking at how we are special and exploring the question: where do we belong? The children will learn about key religious symbols for Christians, Muslims and Hindus and they will explore why many Christians believe that they are special to God.

In **PSHE**, we will be looking at Dreams and Goals - what are our aspirations and how will we achieve them? What is perseverance and what emotions might we feel along the way?

In **Computing**, we will explore how music can make us think and feel. We will make patterns and use those patterns to make music with both percussion instruments and digital tools. We will also create different rhythms and tunes, using the movement of animals for inspiration.

In **PE**, we will explore how to work safely, share and collaborate through our Gymnastics and Cheerleading units. The children will explore creating shapes, balances, jumps and rolls and learn how to put these into a sequence.

Our Projects for this Half term:

Starry Night- This project explores the differences in the world at night compared to during the day. It teaches children about the importance of a good night's sleep, and helps them to discover what is happening in the world while they are sleeping, including finding out about nocturnal animals.

Winter Wonderland - This project teaches children about the changes that happen during winter, including the types of weather associated with winter. It also explores places that have snow all year round and the types of animals that live there.
