Topic this term.... Ground-breaking Greeks

- In **Science**, the children will be consolidating basic knowledge about Electricity, working scientifically and finding out more about where electricity comes from.
- In **History**, we will continue our learning about the Ancient Greeks, focusing on philosophers, the ancient Olympic games and the most significant legacies from Ancient Greece.
- In **Art**, we will continue our topic on Expressionism, working towards creating our own composition.
- In **Computing**, the children will be developing the programming skills with a focus on repetition in games.
- In **RE**, the children will be exploring a thematic unit: *How and why do people mark significant events in life?*
- In **Music**, the children will be studying a unit entitled 'Favourite Song'.
- In **PE**, the children will be working on a range of Athletics skills, including running, jumping and throwing. We will also be refining our Cricket skills.
- In **PSHE**, The Jigsaw unit is 'Changing Me'. The children will be taught in single year groups for these lessons and will be learning about the changes humans go through as they grow older.
- In **French**, the children will be focusing on clothing and grammar structures.
